

WOODRUFF CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING  
TUESDAY, JANUARY 13, 2009

A Special Called Council meeting was held on Tuesday, January 13, 2009 for the purpose of interview for the city manager position. The agenda was posted on the bulletin board and faxed to the local media the week prior to the meeting.

Members of Council present were: Mayor Brad Burnett; Mayor Pro-tem Mattie Norman; Council members Buddy Arnold, Toni Sloan and Tony Kennedy. Council members Gist and Smith were absent due to previous commitments.

Mayor Burnett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and asked for a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter.

Council member Kennedy made a motion to go into Executive Session to hold an interview with a prospective city manager candidate. Council member Arnold making a second to the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Executive Session.
